Encourage all participants to learn the Laws and rules and play within them, always respecting the decisions of match officials and promote the positive aspects of cricket, for example fair play

Actively discourage unfair play, rule violations and arguing with match officials and opposition and recognise good performance not just match results

Place the well-being and safety of children above the development of performance and understand and adhere to club welfare issues and processes

Respond in a timely fashion to communications from the club committee and other elected officers

Ensure player is correctly registered with the club's match fees/subscription platform

Prompt payment of annual membership, match fees and other club related expenses in accordance with club rules. The financial status of the club makes prompt payment essential for all members to benefit from the club facilities.

Players will not be eligible for selection if they are in debt to the club for match fees at time of selection – (Wednesday evening 8pm)

Punctuality at meet times published by the Captains

Taking pride in all SCC equipment and facilities, including adhering to club rules regarding the use of both indoor and outdoor net facility

Respecting the safety and welfare of junior members of the club and being an appropriate role model particularly in regards to smoking and alcohol consumption

Zero tolerance on taking banned substances while on club premises, and not provide minors with alcohol when they are under the care of the club

Endeavour to attend organised practice sessions through the season, the AGM and other club meetings and to support official SCC social and fundraising events

Failure to adhere to the SCC Players' Charter could result in the player being disciplined by a Disciplinary Committee
